

# New Device Information for Years R-7 in 2017

## 1. Background Information

St Michael's College remains committed to providing the best available technologies to our students to improve learning outcomes. As such, it is the College's Integrated Learning Technology Program (ILTP) policy to replace all College supplied devices at the end of their 3-year lifecycle.

All primary school students will have their device replaced at the beginning of Term 1, 2017, with the exception of Year 7.

This is a significant undertaking and investment by St Michael's College and will affect 10 out of the total 13 year levels or over 75% of students at the College.
